- ▶ The term *series* describes items published under different titles that all have the same secondary title, such as a series of individual books that form a trilogy. In archives, *series* may refer to a “record series” or group of items in a collection that have the same format, topical context, or other similarities—[UNT University Libraries](#)
- ▶ A set of manifestations that embody the parts of a work, the issues of a serial work, or the units of a manifestation—[RDA Glossary](#)

PCC offers its members the option to continue to trace series and create series authorized access points in the LC/NACO Authority File.
