What is self-publishing?

Self-publishing is the act of publishing ... without the use of a publishing house or company. ... an author writes a book and completes the entire publishing process themselves, such as editing, designing, and formatting the book without the aid of a traditional publishing company. ... to self-publish, an author will publish a book at their own expense using a selfpublishing platform ...

What are self-publishing platforms?

Self-publishing companies are not publishers

 Provide services such as printing, distribution, design assistance, etc.

Some examples:

- KDP Print (formerly CreateSpace)
- Lulu
- Xlibris
- IngramSpark
- Etc.

Cataloging self-published ltems

Self-published items are cataloged like any other published item but identifying and recording a publisher can be confusing

SHARE Policies and Procedures for Recording the Place of Publication and the Publisher

Place of Publication

- ➤ If no place of publication is located on the item, record at least a country as best determined. Record in brackets: [United States].
- > If you are not certain, end with a question mark: [United States?]
- Example: 264 _1 \$a [United States]

Publisher

- ➤ If a publisher is clearly identified, record the publisher in the
 264 _1 \$b
- ➤ If a publisher in not clearly identified, record the author as the publisher in 264 _1 \$b, in brackets

Where to find a place of publication

The item itself

- Title page
- Title page verso
- Check the author's bio on the item to see if place is listed
- If the author has an authority record, see if it mentions a place

Online

- Amazon
- Goodreads
- Fantastic Fiction
- Place of printing is last resort (ex: Monee, IL)

SHARE Policies and Procedures for Recording a Publication Date

- ➤ Record a publication date in the 264 _1 \$c if it is available on the item. Record the copyright date in the 264 _4 \$c if it is different than the publication date
- ➤ If there is no publication date but there is a copyright date, record the copyright date as an implied publication date in the 264 _1 \$c, in brackets, and record the copyright date in the 264 _4 \$c
- ➤ Do not use a self-publishing platform printing date as a publication date unless that is the only date available. If used, add as an implied publication date in the 264 _1 \$c, in brackets
- ➤ If there is no date of any type available on the item, or from other sources, record an estimated publication date or range of dates, in brackets. 264 _1 \$c [2000 and 2020?]

Are you required to record a self-publishing platform in the record?

- No. All that's required is to record a publisher
- ➤ If you've recorded a publisher, and a self-publishing platform is on the book but not on the preferred source, it does not have to be recorded
- ➤ However, some catalogers will record a self-publishing platform as a publisher because they're not sure, and/or they see the self-publisher listed as publisher on Amazon.com
- Example from Amazon. Publisher: CreateSpace Independent Publishing Platform

If a record in OCLC incorrectly indicates a self-publishing platform as the publisher in the **264** _**1**, but it is not clearly identified that way on the item, record the author as the publisher and record the self-publishing platform as the manufacturer in the **264** _**3 ‡**b

In record:

264 _ 1 \$a [Bloomington, Indiana] :\$b Xlibris Corporation, \$c [2002]


Change to:

- 264 _ 1 \$a [Westminster, Colorado] :\$b [John Doe], \$c [2002]
- 264 _ 3 \$a [Bloomington, Indiana] :\$b Xlibris Corporation, \$c [2002]


Cataloging Self-Published Items

Self-published items are cataloged like any other published item but identifying and recording a publisher can be confusing

Next, we have some examples of recording publication information on a self-published items












Choosing a publisher when there isn't one listed



If no publisher is listed on the item, record the author as the publisher

Title Page – no publication info

Recording the author as publisher

- Record the place of publication in brackets if it is not listed on the item. Since we could not find a place of publication, we will enter United States in brackets
 - Record the author in brackets since we could find no publisher associated with this item
 - ➤ Since there is no publication date on the item but there is a copyright date add an implied publication date in brackets in the 264 _1 and then enter a 264 _4 \$c with the copyright date

Searching for place of publication

Since there is no place of publication listed on the item – we must decide what to put there and finding out more about the author is a good place to start



How it is entered in Polaris


- ➤ The place of publication will be California in brackets because it is not on the item
- ➤ The publisher will be the author in brackets because no publisher is on the item
- ➤ Since no publication date was present but there is a copyright date — we will use an implied publication date in brackets and then also add the copyright date
- 264 †a[California] :†b[Marina Adair],‡c[2023]
- 264 4 ‡c©2023



In this case – copyright is listed as Joey and Melanie Acker – and then Ackers' Books, LLC. Since this isn't a self-publishing platform – but instead a platform to publish Joey Acker books – we will use the Ackers' Books, LLC as the publisher

Searching for Place of Publication

➤ Since there is no place of publication listed on the item — we must decide what to put there and again we will start with finding information about the author



- Record the place of publication in brackets because it is not listed on the item
- > Enter the publisher as shown on the item
- ➤ Since there is no publication date on the item but there is a copyright date add an implied publication date in brackets in the 264 _1 and then enter a 264 _4 \$c with the copyright date



- ➤ The location of Sniktau is in Winfield, Kansas. We will add this in the **264** _**1** \$a in brackets because it is not listed on the item
- We will record Sniktau Publications as the publisher in the
 264 _1 \$b
- ➤ We have a copyright date of 2002 but no publication date. Enter an implied publication date in 264 _1 \$c in brackets and add a 264 _4 \$c with the copyright date

- Xlibris Corporation is a self-publishing and on-demand printing service
- ➤ If a self-publishing company such as Xlibris is found on the preferred source and is not identified as the publisher, record as the manufacturer in 264 _3 to help with matching
- > You are not required to add a 264 _3



> We will use Venice, Florida as the place of publication

Here is how it is entered in Polaris

- ➤ The place of publication will be Venice Beach, Florida in brackets because this information is not on the item
- The publisher will be Archangel Ink
- ➤ There was no publication date on the item only a copyright date so we will enter an implied publication date in the 264 _1 \$c and then add the copyright date in the 264 _4 \$c

Example in Polaris:

264	1	‡a[Venice Florida] :‡bArchangel Ink,‡c[2016]

As a last resort – you may use a printing location and date

➤ If you have a self-published item with no place of publication and/or publication date — you may use a printing location/date only after researching and exhausting all efforts of finding publication information on the item

Made in the USA Monee, IL 02 October 2023

- ➤ You may see this on the last page of a book. This is a printing location and date and not a publication location and date.
- ➤ As a LAST resort you may use Monee, IL and the 2023 date in your record if you have no other options
