Quick Review

A series is:

A group of related resources

Where each resource has:

An individual title proper

And:

A collective title that applies to the group as a whole

The series parts may or may not be numbered.

More Quick Review

Types of series:

Author/Title: Individual parts are by the same

creator

Ex: Mosley, Walter. Easy Rawlins mystery

Title: Individual parts are by different creators

Ex: Latino American history

Series-like phrase:


Appears on a resource but is not considered a series title

Ex: Megan Tingley books

Author/title series may be searched through the title or the author's name (can be done as a scan or keyword/numeric search
