024 – OTHER STANDARD NUMBER

Definition:

Standard numbers or codes published on an item that cannot be accommodated in another field such as the 020, 022, 027, etc.

- 0 – International Standard Record Code (ISRC)
- 1 – Universal Product Code (UPC)
- 2 – International Standard Music Number (ISMN)
- 3 – International Article Number a.k.a the European Article Number (EAN)
- 4 – Serial Item and Contribution Identifier (SICI)
- 7 – Source specified in subfield \$2
- 8 – Unspecified type of standard number or code

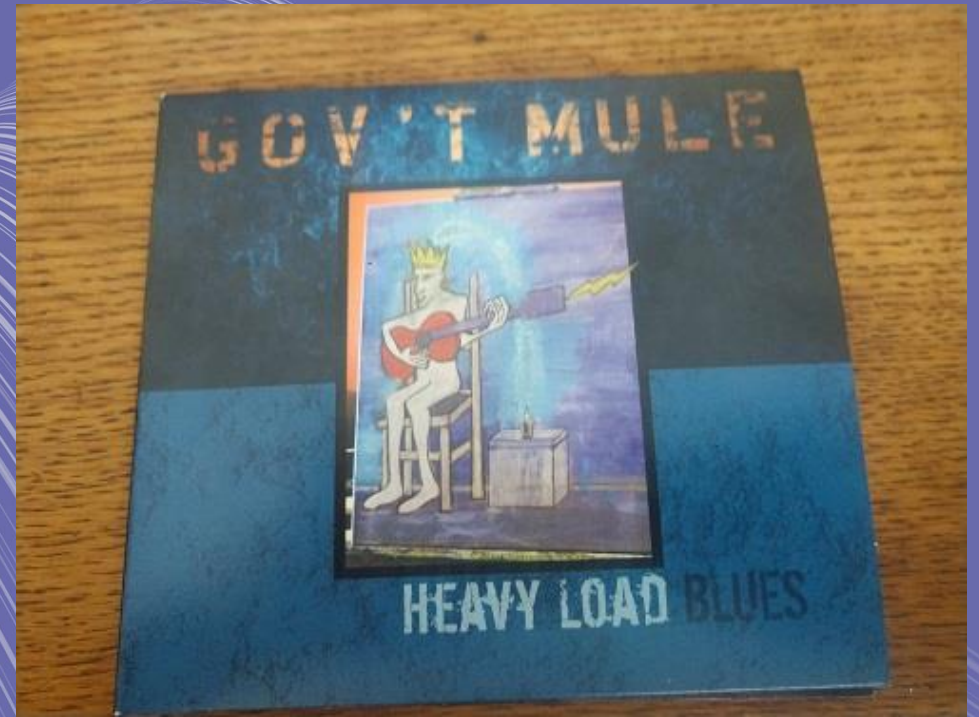

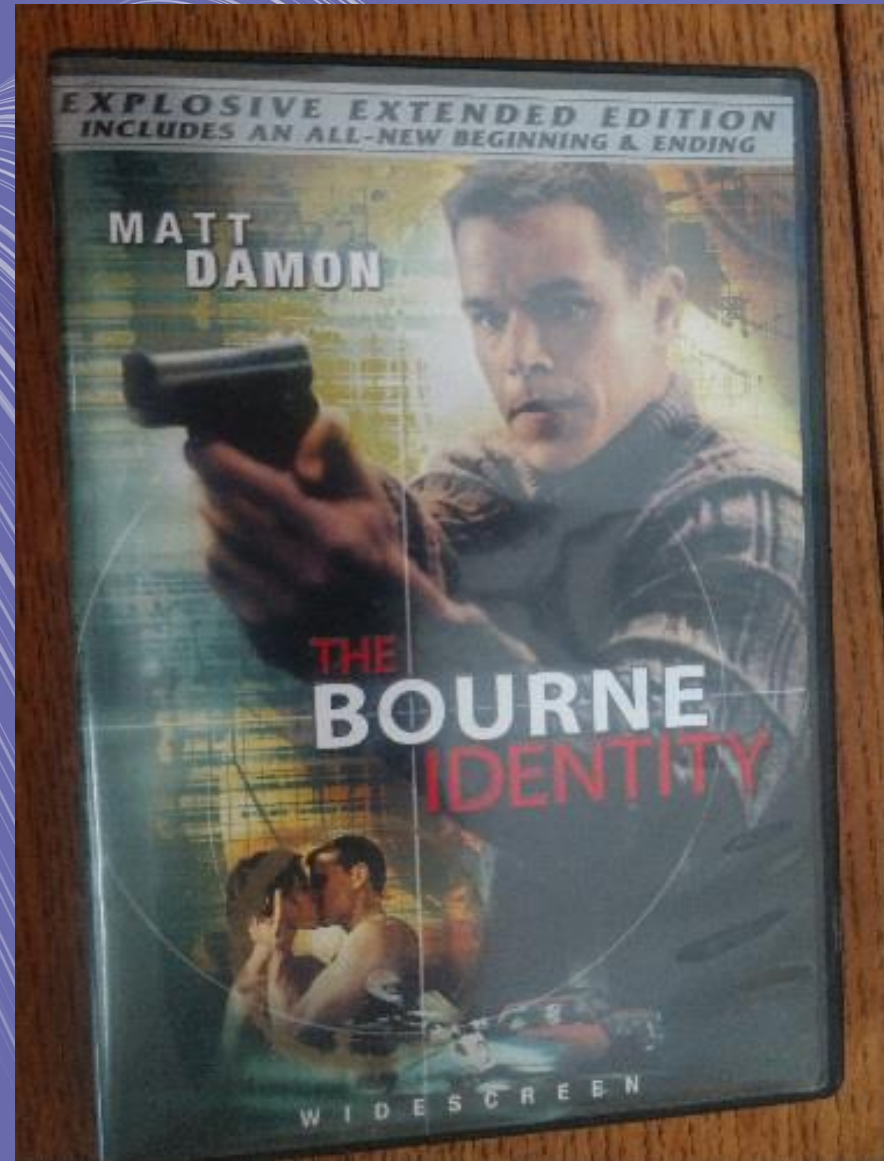

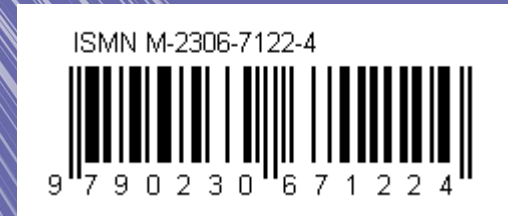

028 – PUBLISHER OR DISTRIBUTOR NUMBER

Definition:

Formatted number used for sound recordings, printed music, other music-related materials, and video recordings. Publisher's and distributor's numbers that are given in an unformatted form are recorded in field 500. A print constant identifying the kind of publisher or distributor number may be generated based on the value in the 1st indicator position. Repeatable for multiple numbers associated with an item.
