MARC Report is a program that validates RDA and MARC coding in bibliographic records. It checks for those many, many little details of RDA, MARC coding, and ISBD punctuation that are easy to miss so that errors can be fixed before records are imported into Polaris.

The latest version is MARC Report 258 and is available free of charge. No license or registration is required, and you can load it on as many computers as desired.

It's strongly recommended that cataloging libraries download and use MARC Report. It's a great product that helps both new and experienced catalogers produce accurate and consistent bibliographic records. And did we mention it's free?
