# Flights of Edncy

Lets teens learn about fluid dynamics in a way they can see and test.

Teens learn about aeronautics in an assessable and easy-to-experiment-with way. Remote-controlled paper airplanes. The compatible app gives feedback on flight time etc.



### Engineering Drones

Gives teens a chance to learn about engineering in a fun, hands-on way.

Teens get to learn about, draw circuits for, assemble, and fly drones.
